## REGULATIONS FOR SHOWS

1. Exhibitors and Judges must be current members of the The Rose Society UK
2. In restricted classes, exhibitors may accept assistance with staging their blooms; however in open classes, they must stage their own blooms
3. Exhibitors should submit entries in writing or by email using the standard entry form supplied with this schedule or down-loadable on the society's website. Late entries will be permitted if space is available, but only if the exhibitor has already made entries prior to the relevant closing date
4. Exhibitors may only make one entry in each class unless otherwise permitted in the schedule. Spouses or partners living together are considered as one exhibitor
5. Star of the Show classes (at all shows) -
  - i) in these classes, exhibitors may make any number of entries but only one exhibit of any one variety in each class
  - ii) exhibitors are reminded that in these classes the roses are judged for bloom, stem and foliage. Star Classes are 'stand alone and do not have a points value for Championship classes
6. All exhibitors and helpers must leave the place in which the competition is taking place at the appointed time. Warnings will be given at intervals prior to the appointed time
7. Exhibits may not be removed from the show tables without prior permission from the Show Secretary
8. All blooms must have been grown by the exhibitor from bushes that have been in their possession for at least three months
9. Any queries regarding judging decisions must be raised before 12 noon on the day of judging with The Chair of Shows or a member of the Committee
10. To assist judging and to provide information for visitors, all exhibits, should be named. Incorrect, or not naming will not disqualify, providing there is no duplication in classes which ask for distinct varieties. Seedlings, Sports, or unknown varieties should be noted on the variety card provided. All entry and variety cards will be available at the shows

11. All rose blooms are to be exhibited free of artificial aids of any kind. The only exception is that Large Flowered blooms may have a single wire inserted to hold the flower head erect. All stems must reach water, or water retaining material. Water retaining material in vases, bowls and containers must be kept below the rim of the vessel to allow watering during the show. Foliage must not be dressed with oils or any other agent. Please use only biodegradable staging materials wherever possible – TRUSK shows allow the 95% biodegradable products.
12. All roses exhibited should conform to the standards set out in the current edition of 'Judging and Showing Roses.
13. All exhibits are to be staged for **frontal effect**, except miniature baskets or where otherwise stated in the schedule
14. Exhibitors **must use** the receptacles provided for staging, which should be used as stated in the schedule. Exhibits must be staged at the show venue during the times noted in the schedule. The society equipment must not be taken away for future use
15. The term 'Miniflora' when used in this schedule, describes blooms that are well above average sized miniature rose blooms. They should not be so large as to appear coarse and be markedly smaller than Large Flowered blooms. Stems and foliage should be in proportion to the bloom. All exhibits in classes defined as 'Miniflora' will be judged as defined in 'Judging and Showing Roses'
16. With reference to 'miniature cluster flowered roses'; the stems of all miniature cluster flowered roses may bear any type of bloom. It should be noted that all blooms should be shown at the perfect stage for the type of blooms entered. HT type should be half to three quarter open; single, double or semi double blooms should be open and have fresh stamens if visible. All other requirements will be judged and defined in 'Judging and Showing Roses'. Judges should show no preference toward any individual type of bloom. Copies of 'Judging and Showing Roses' are available from the Society website and on the secretary's desk at all shows.
17. **Prize money and awards.** Prize money awarded at all shows during the year will be paid at the end of the year except classes that are sponsored with

vouchers. Sponsored prizes will be available for collection immediately after award ceremonies.

**Rose Society UK Silver medals** will be awarded for the best exhibit at each show and presented at the first suitable occasion

**Awards Presentations** will take place at 12.30pm midday on the first day of all shows. All exhibitors are requested to attend this presentation.

Except for sponsored classes, listed below, all classes will carry a points value of;

**4 points for a first prize**

**2 points for a second prize**

**1 point for a third prize**

and each point will have a prize value of £1. In the event of a tie on total number of points, then the highest number of first prize awards will determine the winner.

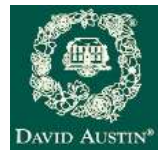
